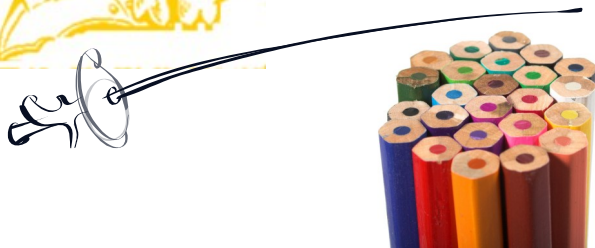

UNIFORM DRESS CODE POLICY

The ultimate goal with our dress code is modesty and neatness. Since time spent in class is limited, we would ask that dress code not become an issue. Please adhere to the requirements as stated.

Shirts: Dress code is mandatory and will consist of a solid color classic polo shirt (long or short sleeve) or collared buttoned up shirt, in Navy blue, light blue, white or gold (yellow).

Bottoms: 100% cotton twill or corduroy, docker-style, cargo-style or khaki-style pants or capris, fingertip length shorts, or a knee-length skirt or jumper in khaki (tan), black or Navy blue. *Stretch or denim pants are not allowed.*

Footwear: Dress shoes, tennis shoes, boots, solid leather or “pleather” dressy sandals or flip flops are acceptable. All footwear should be in good repair. No military combat style boots will be allowed unless a student is breaking in boots for entrance into a U.S. military academy after graduation.

Jewelry/ Make-up/ Accessories: No “Goth” style make-up, jewelry hair, or clothing will be allowed. Jewelry should be worn in moderation and good taste. No earrings are to be worn by male students. Males or females may not wear “body pierce” jewelry.

Ladies make-up should be used in moderation. Boys may not wear make-up or nail polish.

No visible tattoos are allowed in any form, permanent or otherwise.

Hats and sunglasses are not to be worn at any time during the day except during an outside activity. Baseball style hats must be worn with the brim forward. Hats should never be worn inside. **Hair:** Unusually styled hair will not be allowed for ladies or gentlemen.

Gentlemen’s hair must not cover the eyebrow, shirt collar, or below the bottom of the ear. Whether it be combed behind the ear or not, it must meet the standard. Sideburns must not extend below the bottom of the ear lobe. Male students must be clean shaven. Mustaches and beards are not allowed.

Each student is to present a good personal appearance at all times including field trips. Clothes should be comfortable for either classroom attendance and/or activities. We ask that dress be modest and not too extreme. If there is any question in your mind regarding what your child is wearing, the best thing to do is not allow them to wear it.

It is the student and his/her parent who are responsible for proper dress consistent with the spirit and word of the dress code.
